

As per Indiana Code 20-34-4-5, Indiana Law requires that, "Each school shall require the parent of a student who has enrolled in the school to furnish not later than the first day of school, a written statement of the student's immunization, accompanied by the physician's certificates or other documentation, unless a written statement of this nature is on file with the school".

The first day of school will be August 10, 2016 this year. In order to assist with the immunization requirement, the Warrick County School Corporation, in collaboration with St. Mary's Health Services and the Warrick County Health Department, will be sponsoring:
